**Violation #2** Repair rusty spots with broken edges for equipment in playground (located at the end of classroom 266). Provide sign of out of order. It is not in used at time of inspection  
**Code Reference** FAC: Playground Equipment 64E-13.004(2)(a)(c). Playgrounds shall be constructed and maintained to permit maximum utilization of sites with elimination of sanitary and health hazards including mudholes, fragments of glass, stone and similar obstructions. Fixed playground equipment shall be anchored with substantial foundations so maximum safety is obtained. Cushioning materials such as mats, wood chips, or sand shall be used under climbing equipment, slides, and swings.

**Violation #5** Clean inside cabinet and drawer next to sink in classroom 145,152,033.  
**Code Reference** FAC: Maintenance & Repair 64E-13.004(3)(b)(c). Buildings shall be kept clean and in good repair, free from hazardous conditions, such as loose or broken floor tiles and boards; loose moldings; loose hanging fixtures, pipes, and electric wires; and broken plaster. Furnishings and equipment shall be kept clean and in good repair, free of missing parts and hazards such as sharp edges, splinters, and protruding or rusty nails.

**Violation #15** Provide soap in bathrooms 073-men and 072-women  
**Code Reference** FAC: Handwash Facilities 64E-13.004(6)(b). Handwashing facilities shall be located within or adjoining each toilet room. Soap dispensers shall be provided at all wash basins and liquid or powdered soap shall be used. Individual towels, preferably paper shall be used. Use of common or public towels is prohibited. Hot-air hand drying devices
